By signing in the space provided, you have indicated you have **read and understand** the terms of this waiver. This waiver will be kept on file at the PFRC.

1. The undersigned agrees that the Peterborough Family Resource Centre (PFRC):
 - in no way screens persons seeking or offering services
 - in no way inspects premises of persons seeking or offering services
 - in no way warrants the fitness of persons seeking or offering services
 - in no way scrutinizes the credit ratings of persons seeking or offering services
 - in no way verifies the personal references of persons seeking or offering services.
2. Peterborough Family Resource Centre cannot be responsible for any negligence or personal injury, death, or loss, damage or destruction of property caused by persons seeking or offering services.
3. Responsibility for choosing and implementing arrangements lies with the person seeking and the person offering services.
4. I understand that the Child Care Information Exchange is in binder form at PFRC locations, as well as the PFRC website.
5. Peterborough Family Resource Centre staff will not handle or act upon complaints from persons seeking or offering services unless there is professional responsibility to report under the Children and Family Services Act. This Act deals with the protection of children at risk.
6. The name of a person offering services will be removed from the Child Care Information Exchange Binder at her/his request or upon PFRC reporting of a Child and Family Services act incident (C.A.S.) OR a violation of the legal number of children in an informal child care home as set out in the Day Nurseries Act. The person offering services is responsible for ensuring accuracy of information. The Exchange Binder will be updated annually.

Under the Day Nurseries Act, an informal home child care provider may provide care to five children 10 years of age and under per household at one time - no matter how many adults are involved in providing the care. The caregiver's children, regardless of their age, are not counted in the total of five children.

7. PFRC does not conduct health and safety checks, fire inspections or police checks.
8. Licensed In-Home Child Care agencies such as Kawartha Child Care Services and Wee Watch Private Home Daycare ensure Ministry guidelines for in-home childcare are met. These include: monthly home visit, fire inspection, police check, pet vaccines, etc.
